What Are You Going to Do to Help Your Cause?

Need some inspiration?! Here are some ideas to fuel your Super Powers!

- 1.) **Organize a school-wide sale.** Get creative! Make friendship bracelets, slime or pottery and sell your goods on a designated day! It's always a good idea to have plenty of treats and lemonade to sell too. Select a day and advertise your sale on social media. Invite your families and community members to attend your sale. Donate the money you raise to your cause.
- 2.) **Grow a community garden at school!** Research the types of fruits and vegetables that grow the best in Arizona. Give your healthy produce to classmates and or community members. Decorate your garden using repurposed tin cans or other recyclables!
- 3.) **Host a care package drive for our US Military members that are serving overseas.** Assign each classroom specific items to fill the care packages. Ask everyone at school to write a letter or superhero spirit card to include in the care packages. Host a care package "assembling party" and invite members of the community to help sort the donations and pack the boxes. Where are your packages being mailed? Research the geographical location and its culture, Then create a presentation for your classmates.

4.) Create “GPP Superhero Shout Out Jars” for every classroom. (The purpose of these jars is to tell on people for the good things they’re doing instead of the bad.)

- Students are invited to write positive “shout outs” about their classmates and then place the superhero shout outs in the jar.
- Every Friday your teacher will pull a note from the jar. The person who wrote the note and the person who received the note will get to pick a small prize. Remember to decorate your jars with inspiring pictures and quotes.

5.) Host a basketball tournament or a talent show! Invite your friends and family to attend and charge admission, Remember to have treats and lemonade to sell too! Donate the funds you raise to your cause.
